

Borough of Victory Gardens Recycling Information

Paper: Recycle office paper, file folders, junk mail, envelopes, flyers, newspapers and inserts, magazines, catalogs, paperbacks and phone books, wrapping paper, paper bags, tissue and cereal boxes, paper towel cores, toilet tissue rolls, frozen food boxes, cartons and boxes used for milk, juice, soup, broth, etc., clean pizza boxes, 6 pack and 12 pack cartons from soda, clean paper ice cream containers.

Plastic, Metal & Glass Containers: Plastic containers (bottles and non-bottles) coded 1, 2, 4, 5, & 7, plastic caps larger than 3" are acceptable. The smallest acceptable plastic container is a 6 – 8oz. yogurt cup. Glass bottles and jars with caps and lids removed. Recycle loose metal caps and lids. Recycle aluminum and steel cans, loose metal jar lids, steel bottle caps, clean aluminum foil, pie plates and trays. All containers must be empty and cleaned.

Corrugated Cardboard: Cardboard must be tied in bundles not exceeding 12 inches in height or 50lbs in weight. Cardboard shall be clean and not contaminated with food, dirt or any other substance.

Preparation of Materials: Paper recycling shall be done in a separate container from the plastic, metal & glass container. The maximum size container shall be a 32 gallon can and shall not weigh more than 50 lbs. Recycling containers must be placed out for collection the night before collection or no later than 6:00am on the day of collection. All containers must be removed from the curb by 8am the following morning. All containers shall be furnished with a tight fitting lid. **No plastic bags are permitted, recycling in plastic bags will be left at the curb.**

Grass, Leaves & Brush: Must be placed in brown biodegradable paper bags and left curbside for the Borough's DPW to collect. Brush shall be no longer than 4 feet and 4 inches in diameter.

White Goods (Appliances), Electronics & Scrap Metal: White goods shall include; refrigerators, stoves, washing machines, dryers, air conditioners, dishwashers etc. Electronics shall include; desktop printers and printer / fax / copier / scanner combinations, computer peripherals, including keyboards, mice, hard drives and other devices, fax machines, DVD players, VCR's and other video players. Any item containing freon will need a sticker from the Borough Hall at a cost of \$15.00 per item. No propane tank are acceptable. Please call Borough Hall to schedule a pick-up of these items.

Notes: Bulk and Building Materials are not acceptable items for collection.
