NOURISH NJ - I received a call from Terry today from Nourish. She is asking for a letter of support from the Mayor and Council. They are looking to apply for funding for program expansion costs for their building from the Congressional Appropriations .

I asked her if she could give me a little more detail as to what they are wanting it for? She said the money, if approved, will go for food, employment, housing and mental health services to be used for their building in Victory Gardens. Funding will assist with the preparation and distribution of meals and fresh produce, an inhouse 10 week employment program to help people get full time jobs in the community, housing assistance for back rent/mortgage payments and rapid rehousing for people facing eviction and mental health services onsite offered in English and Spanish.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT - I spoke with Linda Clark from Community Development. They want to know how we are paying for the rest of the project for Washington Avenue paying?

The total cost of the project is \$130,898.13. Of that, the grant amount if \$104,500. That leaves \$26,398.13 that we have to come up with for this project to be completed.

I told her we would take it from the American Rescue Plan money that we still have some of. If not that, then we will take it from Capital.

I did ask Joe about this but have not heard back from him yet. I will send this information to Linda and let her know where we plan on taking the money from. The longer we put this off the longer it will take to secure the money from them and for the project ot begin.

Jim Janone - How come Debbe that you didn't mention the GRC complaint that I filed? I never mention them. I wanted the audio from the Planning Board and I was told that I couldn't have it. You were told that by the Attorney, no by me. I never heard backfrom you about the trucks that are parked behind the house on Cooldige. I gave it to Ron to take care of. I told you that. What happen with the discussion on the Housing Officer? Councilsaid that they weren't hiring anyone at this time. The CFO year end report - I filed an OPRA for it and never got it. That is because we never got it. The Council asked for that infromation from the CFO almost a month ago, and I keep reminding him to get it to us and we still don't have it. The agreement for Nourish when did that go into affect? Was it the day they took title or the day they open for business? Well they aren't open for business yet. It was from they took title. That money from the Boardof Education \$750,000 somewhere around there - will that be discussed as part of the budget? We have the money because we never gave it to Dover. However, until an agreement is reached between the Attorneys to present to the bodiesinvolved, nothing will be done. Dover is supposed to do up the agreement and then it comes to us. Some towns are using the American Rescue Plan money to businesses in their towns. How come we aren't doing that? It's used for payroll and losses they may have had. The Clerk said she doesn't think that is American Rescue Plan money. That is a different program. American Rescue is for infrastructure. Also, we still have a project planned and that is if we have money left, we will do the other section of town for the schoping of sewer lines. Are we still paying for pest control? Yes. why? The Mayor said if you have infestation of bugs or anything else, you have to continue to treat. It is prevention. Do they do the firehouse? No, we don't have a problem up there. The phone bill is very high. That is alot of money. It says it is an overdue amount. If it was paid already, it will not get paid again.
